

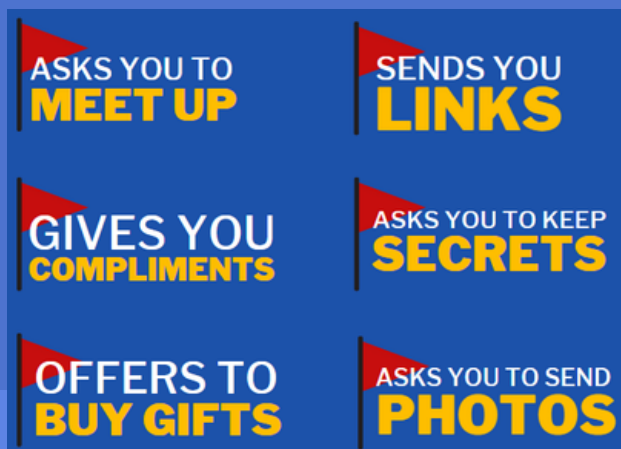

What did your child learn about at school?

Settings are like the Avengers- they protect us when we're online. We can change settings like setting our profile to private and turning off our location to keep us safe.

Red Flags are clues that warn us an interaction may be **unsafe**. An unsafe interaction could have one, some or all of these red flags.



If we experience an unsafe interaction we can **block** and **report** the account and tell a **trusted adult**.

Some conversation starters:

- Why is it important to check your settings when you create an account?
- Check the settings together on your child's favourite game/app- are there any you could change to make their experience safer?
- What are some red flags you might notice when you're interacting online?
- What could you do if you notice any red flags?
